### **Cold Weather**

As the weather seems to have taken a turn for the worse and is much colder, please make sure your child comes to school wearing a coat that will keep them warm. We expect children to be outside if it is not raining too hard and they will need to wrap up warm with a coat, plus a hat and gloves if they need a little bit more insulation. For outdoor PE we allow the children to wear jumpers and long trousers or a tracksuit. We do not expect them to wear coats during PE as this would prevent them being able to achieve a full range of movement and because they get hot very quickly.

### **Spanish Trip**

Ms Valverde has explored the possibility of a trip to Spain much like the Comenius Project a few years ago. She has successfully approached the governing body with a bid and they have granted approval for the trip to go ahead in late May after the KS2 Sats have been completed. The trip will involve liaising with a Spanish school, visiting the classrooms and doing some joint sports and curriculum activities. The children who will be chosen will be those who have attended Spanish Club and have excelled and those who have attended PE and who Mr Gillingham has assessed as a hard worker and who is showing good skills. Those children fortunate enough to be chosen will be receiving a letter next week which will give more details.

# News from the Middle Phase

## Year 1

We have begun the term with an exciting and eventful Inspiration Day to introduce our new creative curriculum topic – *What plants animals and birds would Shrek find in Brampton Park?*

The children started the day by designing and decorating gingerbread men. They then created mini-beasts using a variety of materials. They designed their own Fairy Tale characters and ended the day by making bird feeding balls. The children were eager to learn about the new topic and decide why Shrek and his friends should move to Brampton Park.



In addition to this we are also participating in the Time Explorers Challenge. The Time Explorers Challenge will explore the life of a young Queen Victoria before she was crowned. The children will be reading about Queen Victoria and her adventures with Dash, her dog. They have also received and watched a video message from Queen Victoria and this has motivated them to want to learn more about her; they will do so on our visit to Kensington Palace.

In maths we are learning different methods of adding numbers up to twenty. The children have found this challenging at times but are becoming more confident in the method each day by using concrete and pictorial methods of teaching.
