# News from the Lower Phase Reception

This week the children in Reception have been learning all about the adventures of the 'Naughty Bus'. This is a brilliant book, which follows the Naughty Bus through many different journeys. These include trying to dive through bake beans and water! The children have had plenty of fun, although the naughty Bus never behaved in a sensible way. The children have also been thinking about where the Naughty Bus might travel to next, they discussed possible locations and they have written about their own Naughty Bus journeys. Plenty of artwork has also taken place based around this book. The children have painted pictures of the Naughty Bus and made models.

In Maths, the children explored the concept of doubling by using various hands-on activities such as mirrors or doubling butterflies, where children painted dots on one side of the butterfly wing, folded it in half and doubled!

As a part of our travelling theme all of the classes in Reception visited the Museum of London Docklands and had the opportunity to travel on the Docklands Light Railway. The children took part in activities learning about the differences between past and present modes of transport. They explored the dark alleyways of London's Sailortown and were exposed to various ways of travelling. The children were also given the opportunity to spend some time in Mudlarks- an Interactive space for children.
