Playdough Recipe

- 250g plain flour
- 50g salt
- 140ml water
- 1 to 2 tablespoons cooking oil
- few drops food colouring (optional)

Bubble Mixture Recipe

- 1/4 cup liquid dishwashing detergent
- 3/4 cup cold water
- **Optional** - 5 drops of glycerine(available in supermarket or Pharmacy)
- **Or**1 tea spoon of sugar

Salt dough

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1 cup cold water

Models made from this dough will dry hard when left in a well-ventilated area.
