| <p style="text-align: center;">What is in the Box?</p> <p>Hide items in a box and ask your child to guess what is inside by feeling and describing. Once the items are discovered, play a memory game by hiding a toy – What is missing?</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Communication and Language Literacy Understanding the World |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Create a Bug Hotel in the Garden</p> <p>Find a sturdy wooden box or something similar and layer up cones, sticks, straws (or rolled up grease proof paper), bricks, tiles, pieces of wood, shells etc. Which bugs will visit?</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Expressive Arts and Design Communication and Language Understanding the World |
| <p style="text-align: center;">'Paint' with Coffee, Hot Chocolate and Tea!</p> <p>Just add a little water and a paint brush. Great activity to encourage mark making and it smells great too!</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Communication and Language Literacy Development – mark making Expressive Arts and Design |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Weaving through a Cake Drying Rack</p> <p>Find items you can thread (wool, ribbon, cotton) between a drying rack. What is your favourite colour and why?</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Physical Development – Fine Motor Communication and Language |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Reading Nook</p> <p>Create a special reading nook at home or in the garden.</p> <p>Ideas: Use a cardboard box, add teddies, five favourite stories, cushions, blanket and a torch</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Communication and Language Literacy Development – Reading Expressive Arts and Design Physical Development. |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Daily Walk: Spot Numbers in the Environment</p> <p>Write the numbers 1 – 10 on a piece of paper. How many of these numbers can you spot on your daily walk e.g. door number, car number plates, road signs etc.</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Mathematical Development Literacy Development - reading Communication and Language |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Loose Parts Play Building</p> <p>Find items a child can build with around the home/garden e.g. stones, sponges, cups, plant pots etc. Create a structure and add farm animals/zoo animals.</p> | Personal, Social and Emotional Development Literacy Development Understanding of the World Physical Development – fine and gross motor skills |
