Brampton Primary Breakfast Club

Welcome to our Breakfast Club. We hope you enjoy your time with us and know that your child will have a happy, supported start to the day.

We take children from Reception to Year 6.

Our Breakfast Club is run in a happy, safe environment by staff from Brampton Primary school in the Conference room each morning from 7.30 - 8.55am. Children attending will have a range of healthy breakfast choices - cereal, toast, spreads, fruit and hot or cold drinks will be available.

Registration stops at 8:30am and we will not accept any more children after this time.

Breakfast Club costs £2.00 per child each day which will include breakfast and some early morning activities.

The club have been set up to encourage children to eat breakfast and also to support working parents in our community. Many parents feel it is the most important meal to start the day with and we agree.

After they have eaten breakfast children will be encouraged to go to the quiet tables where they can read, play games, and do puzzles. Large group activities, ICT, games and sport will also take place.

Breakfast Club Rules

1. Children attending breakfast club should be brought to Conference room each morning by an adult. Entrance is via the Masterman Road gate. Please make sure you leave your child with a member of the breakfast club staff and not by themselves in the school or left in the playground.

2. All children should register when they arrive at Breakfast Club and should bring £2.00 daily to pay for their breakfast.

3. All children will treat each other and staff with respect. Any child not behaving properly will have their parents informed and could be stopped from attending the Club.

4. After Breakfast Club - younger children (EY and KS1 aged) will be taken by staff to their classroom door, whilst older children (KS2) will be released from Breakfast Club to the playground to line up or, in wet weather to their classroom at 8.45 a.m.

5. Children at Breakfast Club are the responsibility of Breakfast Club staff and once they have registered children should not leave the club without permission.

6. All parents must sign a consent form for their child to attend Breakfast Club. Please remember spaces are limited and we now have a waiting list. Please make sure your child attend Breakfast Club daily.
