**How many of the animals can you remember?**



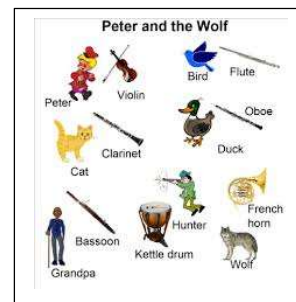
