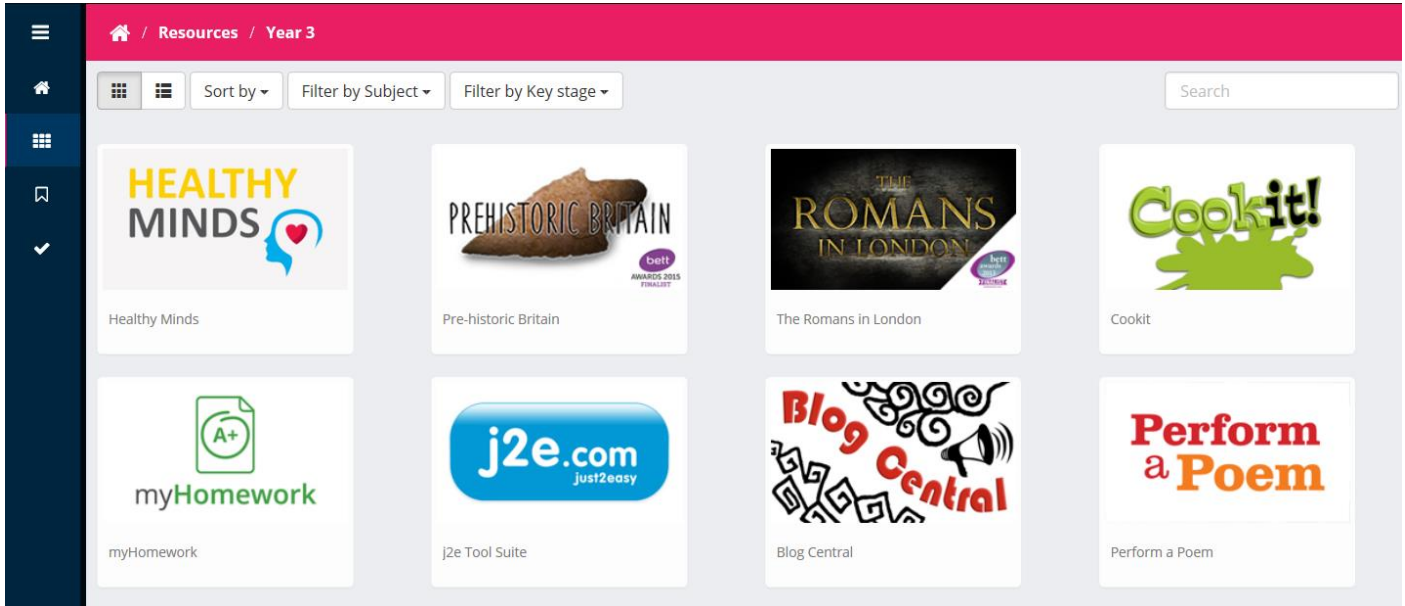
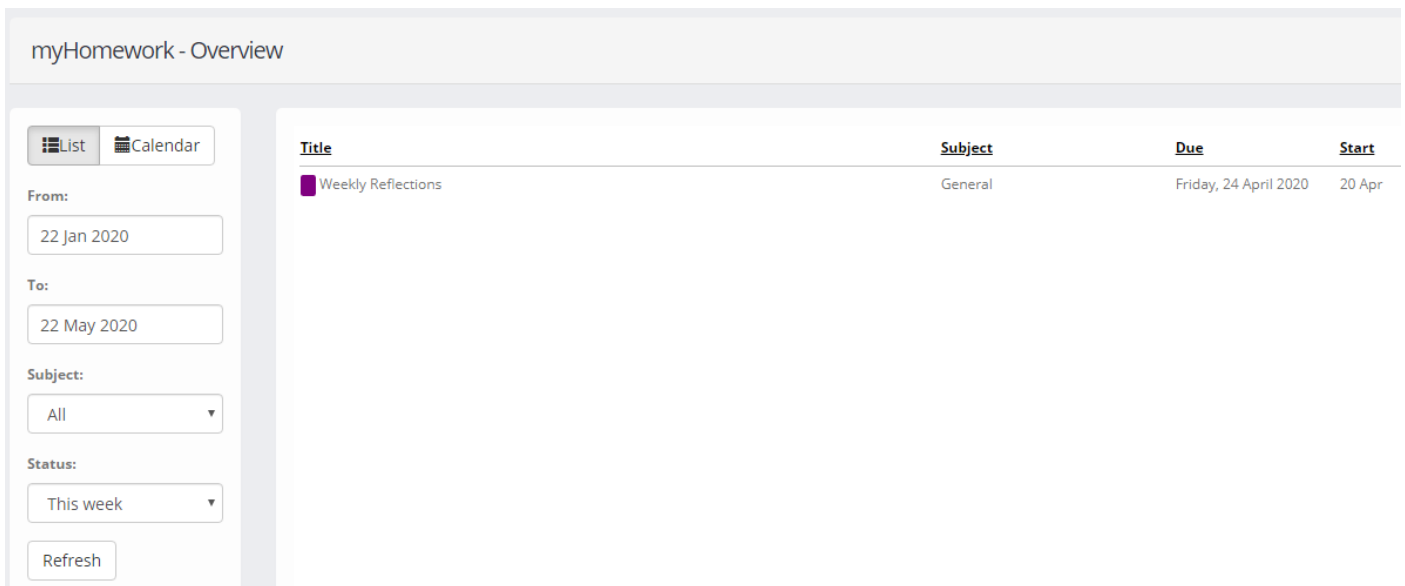


## Pupils Accessing and Completing Work

- 1) You will need to go to the following website: <https://my.uso.im/>.
- 2) Please login using you USO details (this can be done on a computer, laptop, tablet or mobile phone). If you do not have your USO login details, please email your year group's email address, e.g. [Year1@brampton.newham.sch.uk](mailto:Year1@brampton.newham.sch.uk). You will then need to select the *myHomework* button:



- 3) You should be directed to the *myHomework – Overview* section and will see the work that teachers have set:



The work we are asking pupils to do at the moment is based around the Oak National Academy. You will need to complete the daily lessons for that week and then complete the *Weekly Reflection* document – instructions on how to access the document are on the next page.

If you are using a tablet or mobile phone, you will need to write a message to the teacher summarising what you have learnt instead of uploading your Word document.
