English:


Task A: Write a character description for your favourite book or film character.

Money: Use bar models to help you complete the following word problems:

- a) Isra spends 23p on a packet of crisps and 41p on a drink. She gets 36p change. She gives the shopkeeper 2 coins. What were the coins?
- b) Natasha's mother gives her £2 to buy his sister a birthday present. She buys a pencil for 46p. How much change will she receive?
- c) Ibraheem has £2.15. He sponsors his friend Ali 40p per mile for a sponsored walk. Ali walks 2 miles. How much will Ibraheem have left after giving his friend the sponsor money?
- d) Aaliyah has £3.20. She goes with her friend to the school fair. She gives him some money to buy a book and has 53p left. How much did she give her friend?

Time: Use bar models to help you complete the following word problems:

- a) Abhinav began practicing football at 3:30. He finished at 6:45. How long did he practice?
- b) Blessing starts walking to her friend's house at 2.45pm. She estimates it will take her 37 minutes to get there. She tells her friend she will be there at 3.15pm. Is she correct?

Explain your answer

- c) The Stanley family are going on their holidays to Devon. They put the postcode into the satnav.

The satnav says their journey will take 4 hours and 50 minutes. They are leaving at 14.23. Ashely says they will be there at 18.33. Natalie says they will be there at 19.13. Who is correct? How do know?



Science


Forces are pushes and pulls. These pushes and pulls usually change the motion of an object. They could make an object start to move, go faster, stop moving or go slower.
