

Roll and Dot the Number Game



For this game you will need one or two dice, a pen or pencil and a number worksheet. If you do not have a printer at home, you can make your own number worksheet which looks like this one:

To play the game, you must roll either one or two dice, count up the total and circle the correct number with your pen or pencil. A great way to make this more fun is to have a race with two or more people rolling and circling.

To extend this game, you can trace the number instead of circling it. That way you will be practising counting, numeral reading and numeral writing all at once.
