<p style="text-align: center;">Alphabet Hunt</p> <p>Can you find items around the home that begin with the sound... ‘?’</p>	Personal, Social and Emotional Development Communication and Language Physical Development – Fine Motor Skills Literacy Development
<p style="text-align: center;">Favourite Story</p> <p>Focus and use language around title, author, illustrator, beginning, middle and end of the story. Who are the main characters?</p>	Personal, Social and Emotional Development Literacy Development - reading Communication and Language
<p style="text-align: center;">Balls and a ‘Home-Made’ Ramp</p> <p>Experiment with which toys go fastest down the ramp? Predict which toys will travel furthest. <i>Language:</i> furthest, longest, quickest, speed, heavy, light, push</p>	Personal, Social and Emotional Development Literacy Development Understanding of the World Physical Development – fine and gross motor skills
