<p style="text-align: center;">Hide and Seek with Teddy</p> <p>Hide a large teddy or toy around the house and play hide and seek. Practise counting backwards from 10 and use positional language clues e.g. Teddy is under/next to/behind/front of ..?...</p>	Personal, Social and Emotional Development Communication and Language Literacy Mathematical Development Understanding the World
<p style="text-align: center;">Balancing on string!</p> <p>Lay out string or wool around the home or garden and tip toe along it with arms out to balance. <p style="text-align: center;">Counting with pegs!</p> <p>Cut a cardboard strip and count items around the house e.g. how many socks? How many cups? <p style="text-align: center;">Logo Collage</p> <p>Cut and stick logos from magazines, food packaging etc. Look for logos your child recognises. <p style="text-align: center;">Daily Walk: Nature Hunt</p> <p><i>"We are going on a nature hunt, what will we see, what will we hear?"</i></p> <p>Before the outing think about what you may see and jot it down on paper. Tally up what you find on your daily walk (e.g. tree, butterfly, log, bird, large pebble, duck, daisy etc.)</p>	Personal, Social and Emotional Development Communication and Language Literacy Development – reading/mark making Expressive Arts and Design Physical Development Understanding the World

<p style="text-align: center;">Shape Drawing</p> <p>Find items to draw around e.g. cup, small plate, cake cutters, food packaging. Create a shape picture e.g. rocket, house, castle, truck etc. What shapes have we used?
