- A-Z Animal List
 - Can you think of an animal for each letter of the alphabet?
 - Do you know what sound each animal makes? Act them out!
- Draw or paint a picture of your favourite animal and label it. Can you write sentences about it using adjectives?
- Write a set of questions about an animal you would like to find out about.
- Create an animal mask:
 - Using different materials around the house, create a mask of your favourite animal.
 - Think about the colours and shapes.
 - Can you add different textures to your mask?
