Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

I hope you are all well and staying healthy. This week we have seen our Year 1 children settling back into school life and enjoying being with their friends and staff. Next week we will be inviting Year 6 children back on a part-time basis to help support them with transition to their new schools in September.

I know many parents would like to see their children return to school before the summer but regrettably, we will not have the capacity to invite any more children back once Year 6 return to school. Our focus now will be planning for September and we will be sending out information about this before the end of term.

Since the government instructed schools to close in March, we have remained open to children of key workers and those who are vulnerable. I am incredibly proud of the staff who have worked extremely hard under very challenging circumstances. Teachers will continue to set work to complement the lessons on the Oak Academy website and they will still be talking with their classes through weekly Zoom meetings. Members of staff are also inviting children to take part in Zoom 'clubs' where they can develop and practise their skills across a wide variety of topics. There is a lot of speculation and uncertainty in the news about summer schools and catch-up programmes, so **I want to let you know that Brampton Primary School will close for the summer to all children on Thursday 16th July.** I realise this might be disappointing for some parents but the governing board and the school leadership team feel strongly that staff need a proper break and time to recharge their batteries before September.

Please continue to support your child by joining the class Zoom meetings and using the weekly reflections and year group emails to communicate with teachers. Thank you for all your support during these difficult times.
