Activity One

Make your own Spinderella puppet. Remember spiders have 8 legs. You can count the legs on your spider to make sure you have the correct amount.



Here is my Spinderella. I made it from an old egg box and pipe cleaners. I decorated it with stickers.

For the body you could use:

- A yoghurt pot
- A box
- Playdough

For the legs you could use:

- Pipe cleaners
- Match sticks
- String /wool or shoe laces

Activity Two

Take your Spinderella puppet on a counting adventure. Maybe you could take Spinderella outside to the park or garden.

Can you count:

- how many cups you have in your cupboard?
- how many pairs of shoes you have?
- how many ladybirds you see?
- how many friends you see?

Activity Three

Take your Spinderella puppet on a number hunt. Look at door numbers, street signs and bus numbers.

- Can you find the numbers 1-10?
- Can you find the numbers 10-20?
