



# Year 1 Learning Activities

Week Beginning: 29.06.20

- Watch Michael Rosen performing Chocolate Cake here <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zp9b4wx>
  - Listen again and list all of the adjectives (words that describe a noun) that you can hear.
- Make your own game of snakes and ladders and play it with your family.
- Can your child find out what national dishes the following countries are famous for: England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland?
  - What do the dishes have in common?
  - Where do the ingredients come from?
  - After this, ask your child to choose a country of their choice and find out what the national dish is for that country.
  - Is it very different to those dishes from the British Isles? Why?
- Design a new outfit for the summer season.
- On a piece of paper make a grid that has a tens column and a ones column. Give your child a number between 1 and 99 and ask them to draw or represent this number in the grid. You could represent it using items around the house such as pasta, cereal, sweets etc.
- The word 'food' contains the 'oo' sound. Go on a sound hunt around the house and list anything you can find that contains the 'oo' sound e.g. spoon, moon.
- Find out about famous singers and bands from Birmingham.
  - Listen to some of their music.
  - Ask your child to list what they like/dislike about the music.
  - What genre of music is it?
  - Does it remind them of any singers or bands that they know?
  - Create a fact file about the musician/s.
