Have a look at the following activities. Why not try some of them out and record your learning in your exercise book? You could send a photograph of your work to your teacher at year1@brampton.newham.sch.uk.

- Read along to the story 'Everybunny Dance' here <https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/everybunny-dance/>
 - Can you draw the events in a comic strip style, using words such as 'first', 'then', and 'after'?
- Can you add the 'ing' suffix to these root words?
 - : beat, clap, dance, sing, hum – e.g. beat+ing = beating
 - Can you think of any other words that you can add the suffix 'ing' to?
- Transport Through Time
 - Create a timeline of transport from the past to the present.
 - Find a selection of photographs and place them in the correct order.
 - Create a booklet about different forms of transport.
 - Find out about the first aeroplanes. Who was the first person to fly in one?
 - Who invented the first train?
 - Look at pictures of the penny-farthing. Why do you think we don't ride them today? What makes racing bikes different from mountain bikes?
- Can you practise writing the letters of the alphabet in lower case and as capital letters? Can you also practise writing mathematical and punctuation symbols too?
- Lay out each of the different types of coins (1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1 and £2) on the table in any order.
 - Can you name each of the coins and write down their values?
 - Can you order the coins from smallest to largest?
- Can you make a variety of shakers? Using empty bottles from the recycling, fill them with different dry foods/things from the garden.
 - How can you make the shakers sound different?
 - Write a set of instructions for making your own musical shakers.
