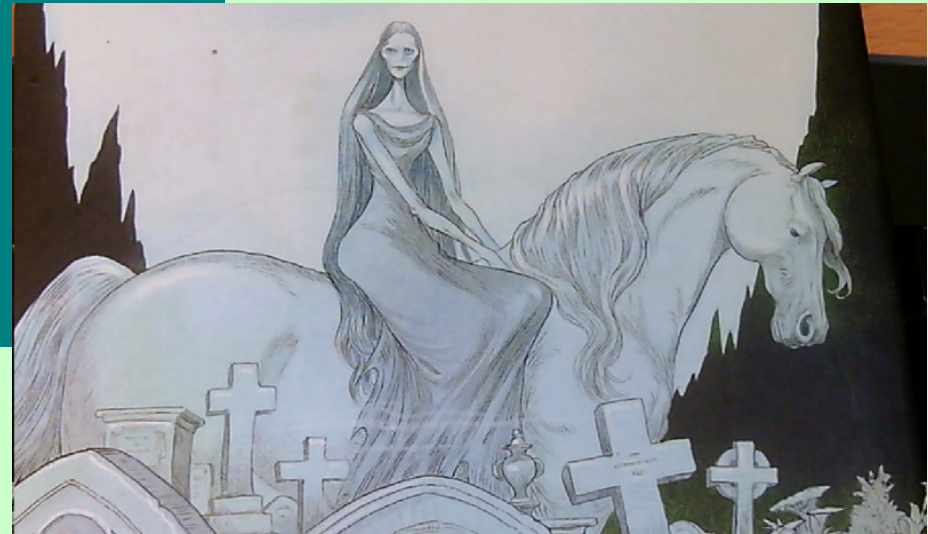
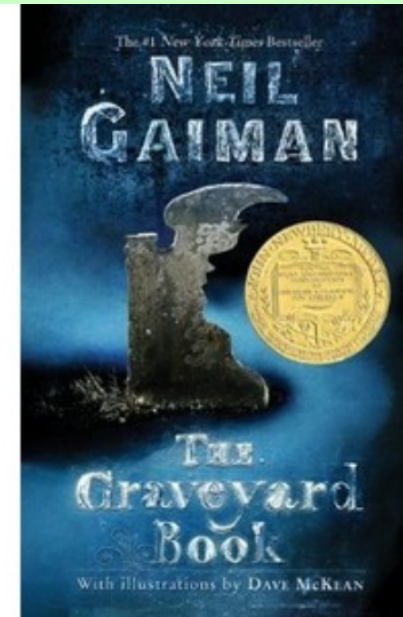
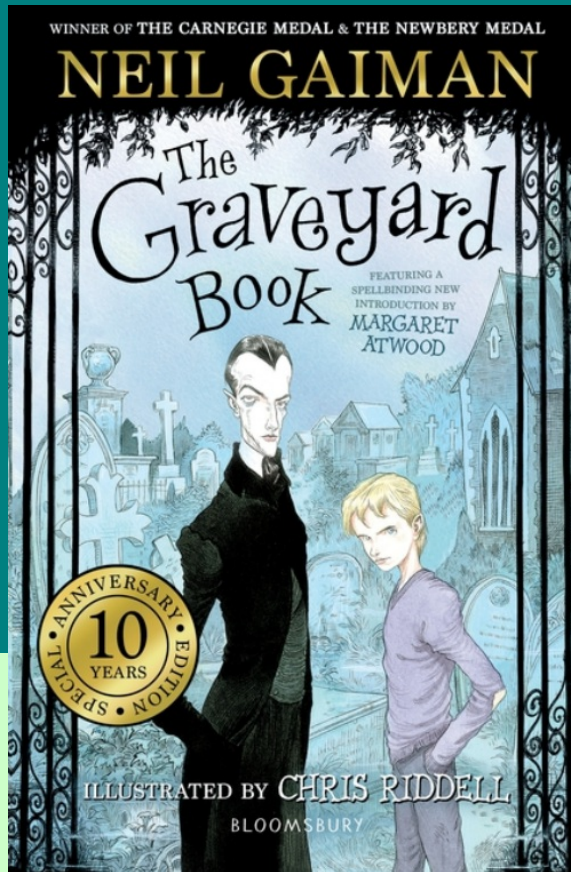

SC1: I can describe, in detail, the images from a text's front cover.

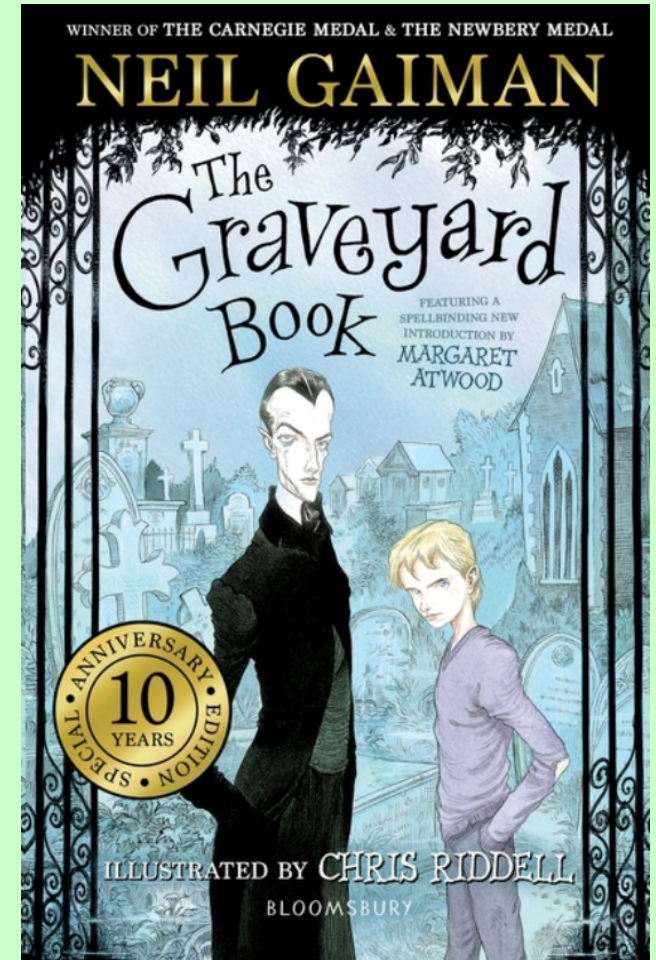
SC2: I can suggest how these images might give us clues about the story.
