Dear Parents/Carers,

Morning and Afternoon Arrangements

We anticipate welcoming around 700 pupils back to school tomorrow and this number will grow as the reception and nursery children begin attending school. As we are not allowing parents onto the school site, we anticipate the mornings and afternoons might take longer than they normally would.

In the mornings, children will be welcomed at the gates by senior staff and guided straight through to their classrooms where they will join their teachers. At the end of the day, the class teachers will lead their classes to their year group's designated gate and release children to their parents.

To help the process run as smoothly as possible, please can you:

- be punctual and arrive on time to drop and to collect your child;
- be patient with staff and other parents, particularly at the end of the day, while we all adjust to the new arrangements;
- maintain social distancing as best you can whilst waiting, and
- move away from the gate as quickly as you can once you have collected your child.

The school has the details of those children who have previously been given permission to walk home alone. We will continue to allow those children to walk home alone again this year.

- If there are any changes to this, please contact the school office and let them know.
- Children for whom we do not have permission to walk home alone, must be collected by an adult.

Emergency Medication - Important

Thank you to those parents who came to school today to bring in their child's medication/equipment (asthma pumps, adrenaline auto-injector etc.) and complete the medication in school form.

If you did not bring them today you must bring them to school tomorrow as it is essential for us to keep your child safe in case of an emergency in school.

Mrs Graham will be outside the school office tomorrow morning from 9:20am – 10:00am to meet any parents who need to give us permission to administer medication to their child in school.
