### Wider curriculum

- What do you already know about The Great Fire of London?
- Create a fact file about the fire that you can share with your friends.



### Science

- What material would be most suitable to make an umbrella out of?
- Test a range of materials in your house using tap water. Which are most/least absorbent? Which is the most/least waterproof?



### Design and Technology

- Design your own umbrella. What materials would you use? What design would you have on the waterproof panels? What tools might you need to use to make it?

### Mathematics

- Practise counting forwards and backwards in tens from any number below ten. For example: 23, 33, 43, 54
- Make 2 digit numbers using pictures of base ten.
- Practise making groups of 2s and 5s. You could use dried pasta to support this.
- Use pictorial representations to practise addition of numbers to 50.

### English

- Retell the story of Hansel and Gretel, in your own words.
