Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

I hope you are well and have been enjoying this lovely sunny weather we have had this week. As you will be aware from the government's announcement on Monday, children will be returning to school on 8th March. Although there is some confusion around which age groups will be going back on which days, we are intending to open fully and welcome all children back to school on Monday 8th March. We are all very much looking forward to having a school full of children again.

We have updated our risk assessment, and in line with the guidance, we will be returning to year group bubbles. We are consulting with staff, and as soon as they have had a chance to share their views, we will place the risk assessment on the school's website for you to see.

I will post another letter next week which will give you more details, including when and where children should be dropped off and collected each day, what they need to bring, lunch arrangements and other information you might need. There will be staggered starts and finishes, similar to the autumn term. We are also hoping to provide a more regular hot meal offer for children. As soon as details are finalised I will let you know. There should be little or no disturbance to your child's learning, but please bear with us so we can make sure that we are completely ready to open safely for your children.

We will hold off from dressing up until children are back in school, but teachers will be planning learning activities that raise the profile of literature and give a powerful message about the importance of books and reading.
