Covid-19 Easter Test and Trace

Schools have been asked that staff remain available for parents to contact should a child receive a positive coronavirus test result within two days of being in school. Please use the following guide to support you:

1. If your child develops symptoms on Friday 2nd April or Saturday 3rd April 2021, you must book a test as soon as possible. If the test result is positive, or if your child receives a positive test result from a test taken before we break up, email the school at info@brampton.newham.sch.uk, and put POSITIVE TEST RESULT as the subject heading.

Please include your child's details – full name, class, last day in school and evidence of the test result.

2. If your child develops symptoms more than two days after attending school, you will still need to book a test as soon as possible, but you do NOT need to inform the school unless it impacts on their return after the holiday.
3. The dates above will be different if your child is attending catch-up lessons in school during the Easter holiday. If they attend up to next Friday 9th and develop symptoms on Saturday 10th or Sunday 11th, which lead to a positive test result you will need to inform us as above.
