Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Kevin had a long connection with Brampton Primary and served on the governing board on a number of occasions and was a local councillor for 28 years. He was very well-known across Newham for being one of the founders of Community Links and, more recently, he set up the charity, Ambition Aspire Achieve (AAA). Both of these schemes provide opportunities and support for people across the borough and, over many years, have impacted positively on the lives of many thousands of young people.

Kevin always supported the school. He would liaise with Lynn McCann every year and donate a huge number of toys and games to help us support less fortunate children with Christmas presents. Only a couple of weeks ago he was able to donate over 100 Easter eggs which were distributed amongst the classes. Kevin was one of the most genuinely kind people I have ever met and he will be missed enormously by everyone whose life he touched.
