Re: RSHE Parent Workshops for Sensitive Topics

We would like to invite you to take part in our parent workshops for the sensitive topics that will be covered in specific year groups this half term.

For **Year 4** parents, we will be delivering a session on how to talk about menstruation and puberty with your children at home, as agreed in the parent consultations.

For **Year 5** parents, the menstruation and puberty session will show you the lesson that we will be teaching the Year 5 children later on in Summer 2.

For **Year 6** parents, the session will cover menstruation, puberty (as part of health education) and human reproduction. As discussed in the parent consultations, parents of children in Year 6 will have the opportunity to withdraw their children from the human reproduction talk; however, they will need to meet with the school to discuss reasons for a withdrawal. This will include going through the contents of the session. Therefore, we encourage all Year 6 parents to join the meetings on either Thursday 10th June 2021 or Friday 11th June 2021 so that they can make an informed decision.

Our workshops will take place online to keep with current government restrictions. The meetings will take place on Microsoft Teams at the following times:
