
The 2020 FIFA Men's World Cup is up and running and children and staff are excited about the prospects of their favourite teams.

News from- Lower Phase Reception

Reception have started this half-term with the traditional tale of *The Three Billy Goats Gruff*. The children have created detailed story maps and have used story language to retell, and act out, the story. As a hungry, stinky and scary Troll had been spotted lurking under a bridge, the children created some Wanted Posters to warn everyone to be on the lookout for the Troll!



During our continuous provision, the children had great fun building bridges and explored how to make the bridges using a variety of materials.

This week, we have listened to the story of *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*. The children have explored the choices and actions of the character of Goldilocks and discussed whether it was a sensible idea to go into a stranger's house.

In maths, the children have been consolidating the skills they have learnt during the last two terms. They have been counting in a variety of ways; for example, forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s. They have been doing lots of independent investigations on number combinations within 20.

This half term in RE, the children learnt about Hinduism and how the senses are very important in Hindu worship. They watched a video about what happens inside a Mandir and explored Hindu artefacts. They also heard the story of Krishna as a young boy and how he liked butter so much, he kept finding where his foster mother had hidden it and eating it!
