Brampton Primary School is involved in a project that runs jointly between schools, the London Borough of Newham and the Metropolitan Police.

Operation Encompass reports to schools before 10am on a school day when a child or young person has been involved in, or exposed to, a domestic abuse incident the previous evening. The project team liaises with a senior member of school staff, known as the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL), to provide any relevant information that may impact on the safety and wellbeing of a child. This enables the school to make provisions for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families.

Any information shared as part of this project is kept confidentially by the school, and only shared on a need-to-know basis.
