Dear Parents / Carers:

Welcome back! We hope you have had a lovely Easter break. We have an exciting term planned ahead, our topic for this half term is '*Travelling and Explorers – Why are explorers very brave people?*'

Home Learning:

Home learning activities are uploaded onto Microsoft Teams in the 'Year 1 Home Learning Team' under the files tab every Friday. These activities consist of spellings related to a particular sound that the children should learn, and write into sentences.

The children should also take home their Reading Record, along with their reading book, each day – their story books will be changed weekly. We would like to encourage children to have discussions with their parents about the books they are reading to support the development of their comprehension skills. Parents and carers should sign the Reading Record daily and leave at least one comment each week about how their child read or make a note of any interesting comments their child made about the book.

The curriculum project can be completed throughout the half term. It will be based on our topic Travelling and Explorers – Why are explorers very brave people? Just a reminder that the project can be based around anything the children wish. It could be a poster, picture, model or a piece of writing.

This Term's Educational Visits

As part of our history topic, *Travelling and Explorers – Why are explorers very brave people?* we will be visiting the Science Museum. The children will have the opportunity to find out how to get astronauts to the International Space Station and how to keep them safe. The children will explore aspects of living and working in space and will observe, describe, test and select materials and equipment to build a space suit.



As part our learning in Religious Education this half term: *What does it mean to belong to Islam?* the children will be visiting a mosque. They will be learning about why it is a special place of worship for Muslim people and they will have the opportunity to take part in a question and answer session with a follower of the religion.

Summer 1 Curriculum

English: The children will read and discuss the books: *Beegu, Man on the Moon*, and *Amelia Earhart - Little People, Big Dreams*. The children will be retelling stories, describing their home planet and writing a biography. They will continue to practise composing sentences and look at different aspects of grammar.

Maths: We will be looking at halves and quarters of shapes, partitioning numbers into tens and ones and exploring numbers to 100.

Science: Identifying and naming plants.

RE: The children will be thinking about 'What does it mean to belong to Islam?' They will learn about Islamic beliefs, practices and lifestyles by studying holy days, artefacts and festivals.

History & Geography: The children will learn about famous explorers such as: Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong, Amelia Earhart and Matthew Henson and find out where in the world they explored.

Design and Technology: We will be making a healthy and nutritious smoothie.

PSHE: Relationships: identifying the members of a family and understanding that there are lots of different types of family. The children will also identify what being a good friend means.

Computing: Programming – Introduction to animation.

Music: Making our own musical story, A Rumble in the Jungle.

PE: Sports - Athletics
