Dear Parents & Carers,

As a rights respecting school and in line with our school vision, we believe that children have a right to enjoy their own culture and have a strong sense of identity. To celebrate the diversity of cultures in our school, we will be having an international cultural week of events. There will be several events happening throughout the week which we will like you to join in and contribute to where possible.

Please read this letter carefully so that you know exactly what is happening each day.

Monday 22nd May – Citizenship Assembly

We launch International Week with a Citizenship Assembly. Class teachers will identify children and who have gone over and above to demonstrate the core skills of following school rules, treating everyone with respect, standing up against discrimination and for equal rights.

Tuesday 23rd May - Art from across the world

Our children will focus on learning about Art from different parts of the world. The Art work produced will be shared in our Art gallery.

Wednesday 24th May – Showcasing cultures of the world through dance

Luckily for us at Brampton, our classes are already named after countries. Each class will learn a dance from their class country or a country of their choice with their phase continent. The performance will be recorded and shared with parents on MS Teams. This will be available for parents to watch at any time.

Thursday 25th May– Celebrating culture through food and language.

Food and Language are two of the many ways cultures are identified and celebrated around the world. Children will learn to write a recipe in the language of their class country. This will be collated and produced in a booklet form. You will be able to pick up a copy from your child’s class teacher or at one of the food stalls on Friday for a small fee. Also, on this day one parent of a child from each year group will be invited to take part in a MasterChef style cooking/meal competition.

Friday 26th May – Celebrate Me/Carnival

All children are invited to come to school wearing traditional clothing representing their heritage and/or identity. This could be traditional clothing from your own culture or that of another culture – Be as creative as you want.

We ask that children should still wear sensible shoes to prevent them hurting themselves as they will be going out to play at break times. We also ask that children do not come to school wearing anything that you consider valuable, as we cannot guarantee it wouldn’t get damaged. It is important that the children are comfortable in whatever they are wearing for the whole day. During the day, the children will show off their outfits in a fashion show/carnival in their phases. This will take place in the school playground. To make the day extra special, parents are invited to bring a dish from their culture to share with other parents, staff and children. We will set up a food stall where the food will be displayed. If you will like to bring food in, please send your name and the dish you will like to bring to the year group address and we will contact you with further details. The school gate will open at the normal time and parents can join in the celebrations.

If there is anything that you are unsure about then please ask your child’s class teacher or a member of the school leadership team who are at the gates in the morning and afternoon.

This is a lovely way of bringing the school community together and we are certain that the children will learn a lot and have a fun time.
