For children in Key Stage 2, the opportunity arises to design our school's rights-respecting mascot, ensuring that it embodies our school's dedication to being a rights-respecting school. Those opting to participate in the competition are invited to submit their entries to their respective teachers by April 19th. Each class, in collaboration with their teacher, will then select the standout entry to progress to the next stage. Furthermore, children in Key Stage 1 and Early Years will collectively design a mascot as a class.

From the pool of selected entries, an impartial panel will choose the top three designs. These finalists will then embark on a campaign journey, culminating in an election day during the summer term.
